Activity 2.

PRESSED FLOWER ACTIVITY- Book mark

Materials Required: Paper (any colour, A-4 size), scissors, leaves, Fevicol/glue, a heavy book, tissue paper and flowers/ leaves of your choice.







Steps:

Step 1: Gather flowers and leaves of your choice.

Step 2: Once collected, take a heavy book and place a tissue paper. Over the tissue paper, place the flowers and leaves of your choice. Put another tissue paper over it and close the book. Keep some more weight over it and leave it for a few days.

Step 3: Take a paper. Measurement for the bookmark- 1.5" x 5". Cut accordingly.

Step 4: Now place the pressed flowers over the paper and carefully stick it with Fevicol.



Step 5: Write a quote of your choice, neatly. Your bookmark is done.

SCIENCE

<u>ACTIVITY 1-</u> Now-a-days people are resonating more towards ayurvedic treatment rather than any other. Andman and Nicobar island is an almost remote and separated part of India situated between the Indian ocean. Hence the ayurvedic treatment done by the people there is a little different than what we used to do in other parts of India.

Find out any 4 ayurvedic treatments done in the region of Andman and Nicobar to treat digestive problems at home. Imagine yourself as an Ayurvedic doctor and design a Brochure. Prescribe these treatments in a self made prescription form made on an A3 size sheet. You can take any imaginative name for your hospital and write all the 4 treatments in one prescription form itself.

<u>ACTIVITY 2-</u> The concept of pro-planet people and the focus on individual behaviour is derived from our ethos of living close to nature; taking from Mother Nature to satisfy our needs and not our greed. To celebrate International Yoga Day on 21 June to perform the following task-

Focussing on all the **SDG 3 - GOOD HEALTH AND WELL BEING**, which ultimately leads to better worldliness, design a newspaper on an A3 size sheet, highlighting the significance of Yoga. Use your creativity to start with slogans, world scenarios etc. The newspaper must contain the following points:

- 1. Significance of doing yoga
- 2. Health benefits of doing yoga
- 3. Any other G20 country which follows this yoga routine and changes observed by them in their lifestyle.



<u>ACTIVITY 3</u>- A sustainable plan for increasing crop production requires nurturing saplings in the early stages of growth. Greenhouses are used by farmers for the same purpose.

Prepare a terrarium in any transparent container displaying any one habitat of your choice. Also highlight the features of that habitat using suitable tags placed inside the terrarium itself. <u>Instructions to prepare a terrarium are as follows</u>:

1. In your clean and dry container, layer up your pebbles to about 2-3 cm.

<u>Top tip</u>: Vary your design by turning the container on its side instead, so the lid is pointing to the side rather than upwards.

- 2. Next add the soil. You only need to scatter it across. (If you have some sphagnum moss, you can add it after this).
- 3. Layer on the potting soil. Ensure there is enough, so the plant roots sit comfortably deep inside it.
- 4. Your biggest plant goes in first.
- 5. Using your small trowel, or long-handled spoon, make a hole for the plant.
- 6.Gently place the plant into the soil. You can use a pencil-like tool to fill in and flatten the soil around it.
- 7. Make sure your plant has enough room to grow a little; don't cramp them against the glass.
- 8.If you have more, keep adding the rest of your plants.
- 9. Place in other stones, or maybe some moss or sand to cover up the soil if you want to.
- 10. Look for aesthetics and enhance its appearance using your creativity.

<u>Activity 1</u>: The G20 Logo draws inspiration from the vibrant colors of India's national flag – saffron, white and green, and blue. Below the G20 logo is "Bharat", written in the Devanagari script.

Instructions:

- 1. Use only Eco-friendly material to make your 3D logo.
- 2. The size of the logo should be appropriate i.e not too big nor too small.

Activity 2: Andaman and Nicobar Island, an archipelago territory of India, is widely famous for a cornucopia of tropical destinations and tourist activities. These islands are known for many things from beach holidays to trekking to marine wildlife and sea adventures. Apart from these, the island houses a small but exotic range of local markets, handicraft emporiums and shopping stops (locally called gift shops) for tourists. Although the islands are not known among the top shopping destinations of the world, when there, keep some time out to shop for something local, organic and memorable!

Memories from Andaman!

Prepare a small album of all the souvenirs (a thing that is kept as a reminder of a person, place, or event) of Andaman and Nicobar island. Paste pictures of the souvenirs along with its brief information. Instructions:

- 1. Prepare a beautiful cover page of the album keeping the Andaman and Nicobar island as a theme in your mind. Make sure to cover it with a cellophane sheet neatly.
- 2. Prepare a spiral album by using colorful sheets and images(use only good quality HD images). The size of the album should be equal to your social science notebook.
- 3. You can also paste real objects like pearl jewelry, shells etc(if available with you).
- 4. Make your work presentable and take care of aesthetics.

Opening Images

Click on File menu, navigate any image and click on Open to open the image file. In this example, we have chosen an image of flower. Your image may vary from the given image.

Changing the Size

- 1. Select the desired part of an image by using Crop tool.
- 2. Make the canvas size bigger from the original image.
- 3. Cover the extra part of the canvas by using Clone Stamp tool.

Exposure Correction

- 1. If the image is overexposed, i.e. there is too much light, you can correct the exposure by using the brightness-contrast level tool.
- 2. Apply dodge and burn tool wherever it is needed in the image.

Applying Filter

- 1. You can give your image an artistic look by applying filter to it.
- 2. Click on Filter menu, then select Noise and then change the amount of noise.
