



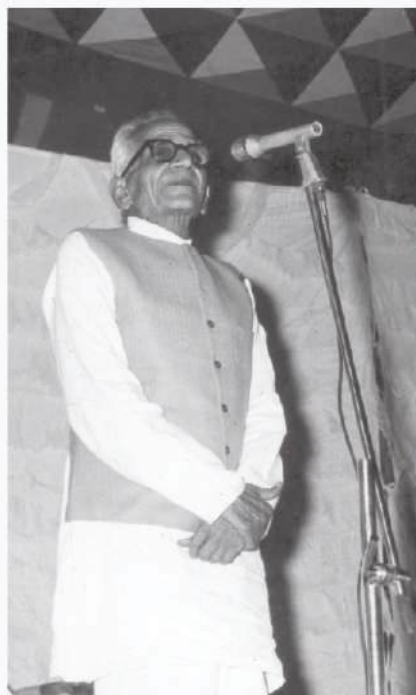

As we grew, we moved to Pitampura in 1985 and re-named the school to K-IIT World School.

We have covered a long distance since then. Today, we count down to year sixty on the way to infinity, and share with you six forces that sustain our vision to support your children's aspirations. As we approach this milestone, and ready ourselves for many more milestones in the future, we hope you will enjoy these glimpses of K-IIT's exciting and fulfilling journey.

KNOWN FOR OUR WAYS OF TEACHING

In K-IIT, IT stands for Innovation in Teaching.

K-IIT World School's learning experience is designed to bring out the potential from deep within every child. We discover possibilities in each child, and nurture those possibilities through **personalised learning and individual development plans**.

We are known for innovation in teaching, curriculum and pedagogy developed in our school.



Dr. T P Sasikumar - space scientist, educator, and Former Deputy Director, PM Office, Govt. of India led a two-day workshop for us.

INTERDISCIPLINARY APPROACH

- **AI-integration:** We develop AI-integrated lesson plans for CBSE with INTEL for Math, Hindi, Social Science, Science, English.
- **Multi-disciplinary approach** encourages linkages between disciplines and embeds Art into the STEM subjects, blends music and sport into learning. Student Parliament participates in the administration of the school and speaks for the student body.

EXPERIENTIAL PEDAGOGY

- **Peer-to-peer-learning:** students engage with peers to learn from each other. Project NIRMAAN made of Pradyo-geek, Waqtaa, Taveer are student groups that drive creativity.
- **Global online sessions:** Themes such as gender, creativity and development are debated with partner schools in the UK, Korea, Germany, Poland, Uganda. The practice was started in 2005 and continues even today.

- **Self-reflections & critical analysis** are built into the almanac to become a daily routine. Dr Bhatia has been recognised with the National Award to Teachers, 2008 by the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India, for the practice of self-reflection.
- **Storytelling and reading spaces:** Storytelling becomes a way of teaching life lessons that all students love. Special assemblies act as a window to the world.

We carry the majority of students to excellence.

- Students achieve the highest bracket of over 95% every year.
- Many are achievers (not just one) and score over 90%.
- Winners and top-rankers in NTSE (National Talent Search Exam), NEET, IIT JEE (Advanced), Mukhyamantri Vigyan Pratibha Pariksha (MVPP)
- More than two-thirds of students every year secure distinction
- Students excel in the Science Exhibition, Quiz Competitions, debating and declamation, National Children's Science Congress, Olympiads.

- **Microanalysis coupled with Gap Analysis**, allows teachers to focus on each student's strengths and areas for learning.
- **Progressive Learning Curve**, the precursor to the Holistic Progress Card. Tracks growth in learning over time to take students to excellence.

CBSE and DoE host events including Capacity Building Programmes, India Heritage Quiz 2022, Zonal Competitions at the school.



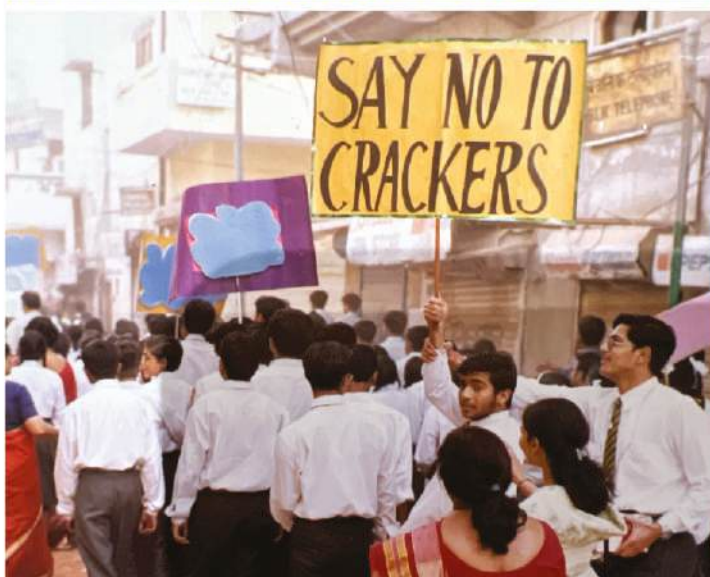

**Shaping The Future:
Redefining Education,
Inspiring Change**

In Sangeeta Bhatia, recipient of the 2020 National Award for Teachers in 2020, is recognised as a change-maker in Indian education, at the very forefront of progressive K-12 teaching and learning paradigms. Under her dynamic leadership, K-IIT World School Delhi, established in 1995, offers students the latest knowledge and skills backed by mentorship and opportunities to stay with the energy and aspirations of India.

We explore the future of education in an insightful interview with Dr. Sangeeta Bhatia.

What pivotal moments in your own education shaped the educator you are today?

As a student, I experienced Indian education in many ways – from a government school to graduate, post-graduate and doctoral studies at the prestigious Delhi University and completing courses at that esteemed. Each institution deepened my understanding of the diversity of education required for an inclusive India.

During my doctoral programme, I reached a plateau and had to make a breakthrough. After struggling, suddenly I came to a turning point and completed six months of work in just three weeks. This personal breakthrough inspired my belief in human potential, that is captured in our motto, "I am a Pioneer, I am a Possibility".

How do you translate your personal learning philosophies into the classroom environment?

K-IIT World School is defined by a single-minded purpose – to unlock the unique potential of every child. Every school day comes packed with learning opportunities, from visiting the Book Fair to exploring biodiversity in Uttarakhand. Through these and many more classroom activities, we discover the possibilities within each child of our diverse 2000 strong student body. Our Centre for Innovation in Teaching & Learning (CITL) encourages teachers to experiment and drive teaching-learning methods that empower children – helping them break free of personal, societal and environmental constraints to achieve their unique potential.

What are your thoughts on the current trends in education, such as the rise of technology and digital learning platforms? How do you see them shaping the future of education?

The key question we must answer today is: how does technology support people? Without people, technology is meaningless. While educators foster 21st century skills and technological advancement, they must not lose sight of the empathy and kindness, and create ethical boundaries for using technology. At K-IIT World School, we foster competencies to drive scientific progress – from Artificial Intelligence (AI) to genetic research – and ensure values-based learning. The options at K-IIT World School are named on this principle. The section 'Curiosity' stands for a sense of inquiry that is core to STEM, while values of community engagement and societal contribution are defined by sections for 'Connect' and 'Care'.

What values or skills do you hope every student carries forward after their time at K-IIT World School?

Reflection, self-awareness and meta-cognitive practices are core to our pedagogy and I was honoured with the National Award for Teachers in 2020 from the President of India through the Ministry of Education (then Ministry of HRD) for my work on reflective practices. Students practice reflective journaling daily, fostering engagement with the self that we aim for them to carry into the future, as this habit, accompanied by empathy and contributes to a better world.

What is your perspective on the current education policies in India?

The National Education Policy 2020 sets up a transformative agenda for India's education system. We are poised to make the most of this new direction. The focus on age-appropriate development milestones and an integrated approach to learning are a positive shift. We have fully integrated curriculum and pedagogy between primary, secondary and higher secondary approaches. Our priorities now are to equip teachers with new skills and knowledge, and foster stakeholder collaboration. Many futuristic initiatives such as AI integration, and interdisciplinary learning are now in place, and we continuously engage with the schools, stakeholders and parents to realise the vision of NEP.

In your view, what qualities make an educator truly exceptional, and how do you nurture these qualities within your school staff?

K-IIT World School stands for education that is ahead of the times, with the I and T in K-IIT standing for Innovation in Teaching. We conducted Action Research on Teacher Competencies for NEP 2020 that showed that teachers need to go beyond subject matter expertise to a Gandhian method to adapt and evolve. Jonathan Meehan says, "The species that survives is the one that is able best to adapt and adjust to the changing environment in which it finds itself." So, my role is to keep teachers up to date with the latest educational enhancements. Teachers and administrators undergo extensive training through capacity building programmes and on-site and Swagat platforms and then bring these

experiences back to enrich others in the school.

Looking forward, what changes do you envision in the education system over the next 5 to 10 years?

Education is a moving target that reflects the complex realities of society and the environment. I see a need for education today to be driven by larger goals like the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). These set a powerful agenda, and education must build on them. We must build a better world for our children and teach them how to take this charter further.

How would you like your students to remember you, both as an educator and as a person?

As one who taught them valuable life-lessons and encouraged them to contribute to each other's individual transformation.

What do you think is missing in the current education system that could better prepare students for the future?

Education is key to change. We have a great vision, and many educators have powerful ideas that are truly transformative. I admire visionaries such as J. Krishnamurti and Subinashini Jagann, who exemplified both vision and action. I would like to see a culture of institutions building like roots – a world where ideas are transformed to on-ground reality. In the words of Rabindranath Tagore, "You can't cross the sea merely by standing and staring at the water."

If you had the power to implement one change in the education system today, what would it be and why?

I would make it accountable – for delivering on the promises of education.

What is your view of the New Education Policy (NEP) 2020 which was implemented last year? How would it change the school education scenario?

The NEP has a holistic view of the student's learning journey that breaks down silos of discipline and level. It has breathed new life into Indian education, taking it beyond disciplines and integrating it right from pre-nursery to higher education. The role of the school now is to build complete preparedness of students in every subject at each level, so one year works as a solid building block for the next. Did you learn discipline, discover your own strengths and resilience, and find drive and ambition? If so, the exam has set you on the road to success."

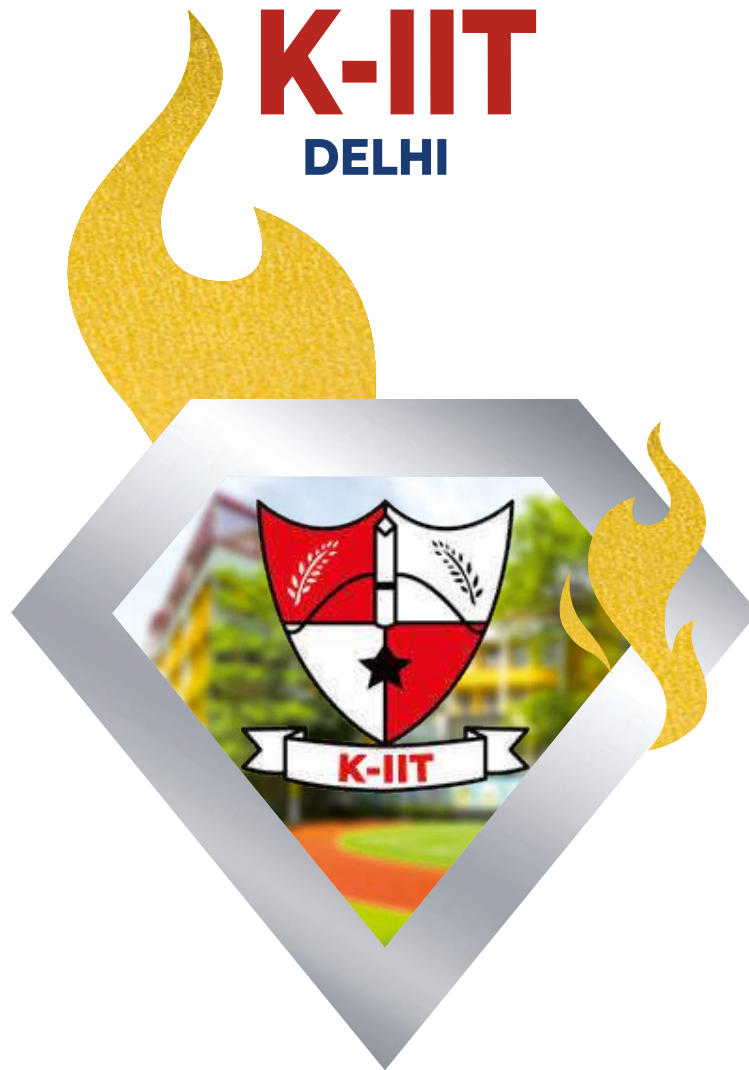
