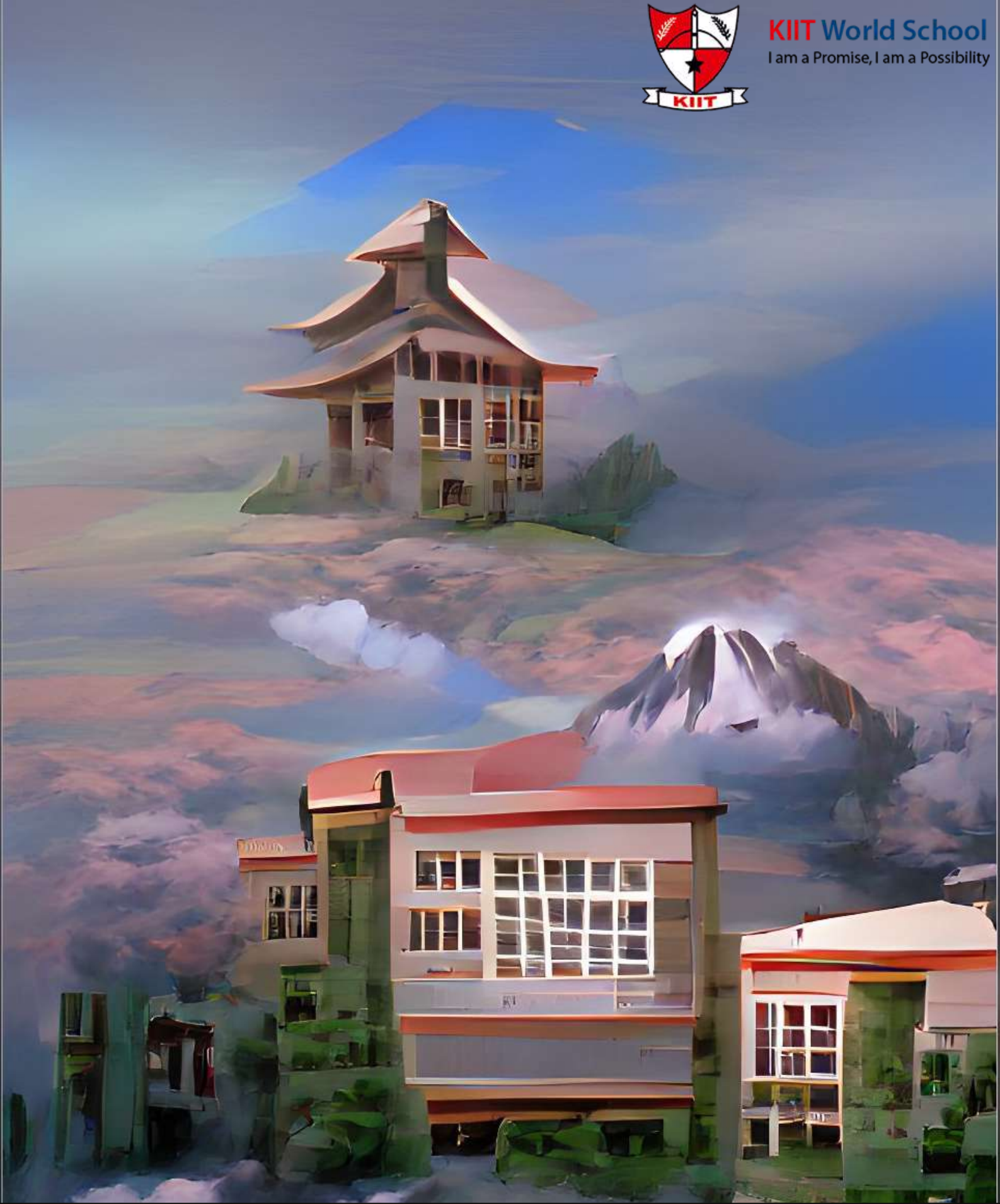

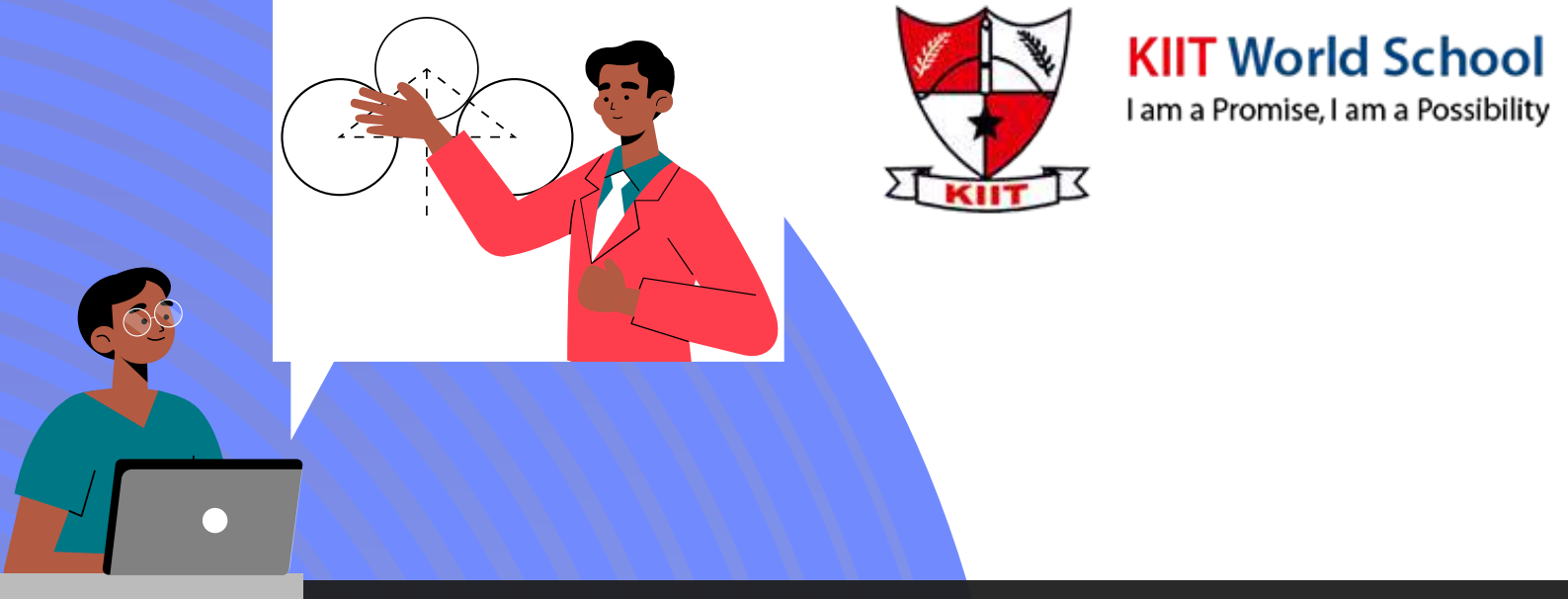
CHABEEL AT KIIT

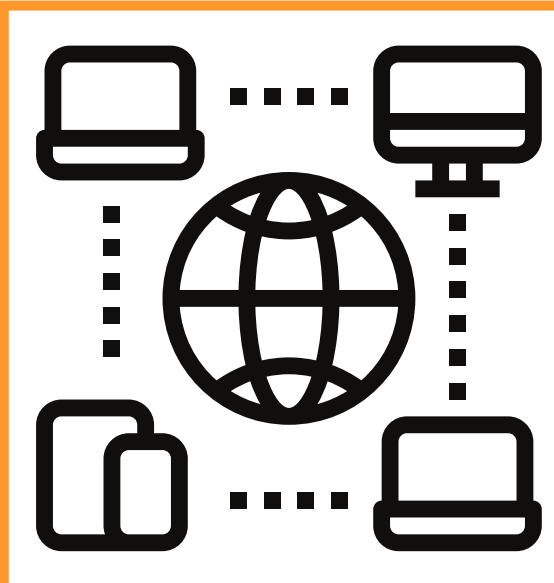
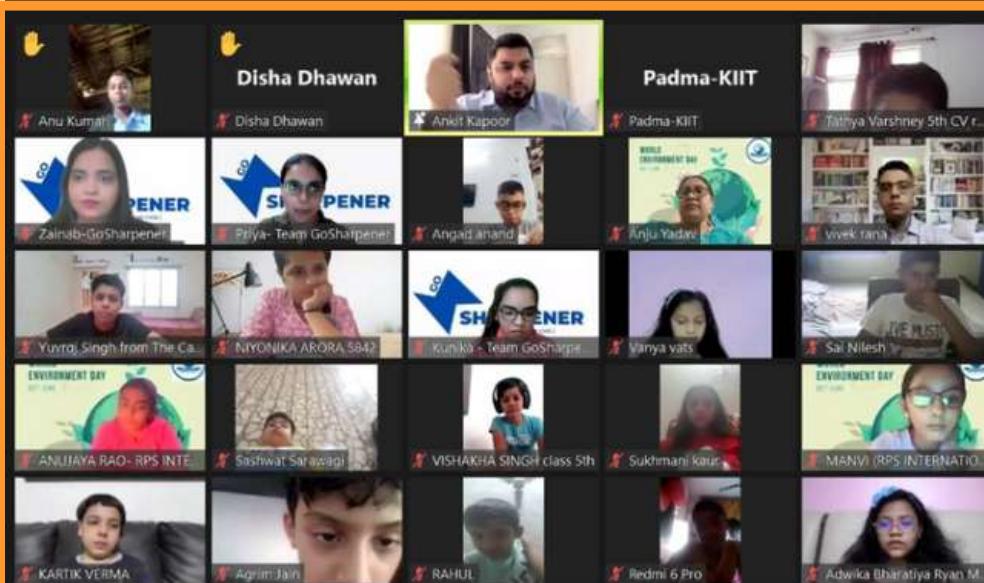

HONING SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES

GLOBAL CONFERENCE ON WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY

Teachers and students from KIIT World School attended the Global Conference on World Environment Day. The theme of the conference was 'Let's nurture nature for a better future. Mr Souparno Banerjee from the Centre for Science and Environment was the guest speaker who apprised the audience about the harmful effects of plastic on the environment and what are the alternatives. He also talked about waste management, which is the need of the hour. He made the audience realize how small modifications in our lifestyle can bring about phenomenal change. Since we consume more, there is more generation of plastic waste. He shared some shocking data that 80 % of plastic waste is dumped, 79 % of all plastic produced ends up getting into oceans, and water bodies, choking the life underwater, 12 % is burnt for generating energy and only 9 % is recycled.



All the major metro cities in India are the maximum producers of plastic waste, which is quite alarming. This is impacting the quality of life of people in metro cities. In order to bring about a paradigm shift, he focused on the transition from a linear to a circular economy and urged the audience to acknowledge that there is a need to take measures at a war footing and take responsibility for conserving the environment at an individual level, community level and national level. He encouraged the use of alternatives to plastics like bioplastics, biodegradable plastics, compostable plastics and conventional materials to name a few. .

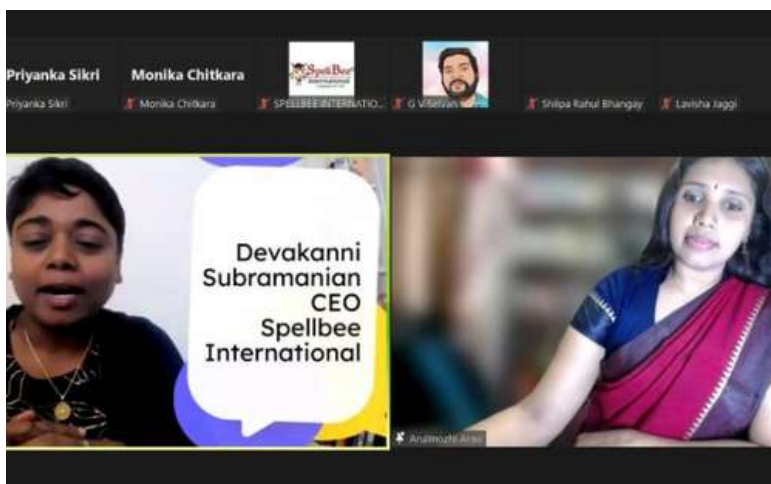


The session was followed by a quiz where students answered the questions based on their understanding of the theme. The students shared ways to replace plastics in their daily lives like discarding the use of plastic straws, bottles and disposable cutlery, using cotton and jute bags for shopping, etc. Mr Vivek Rana, from WaterAid, an

international Non-Profit Organization working towards water sanitisation and hygiene, talked about spreading awareness about clean water and taking it to every household

THE WAYS AND WHAT'S OF ENGLISH SPELLING

Teachers of KIIT World School attended an online session on 'The Ways and What's of English Spelling' organized by Spell Bee International. The resource persons Ms. Devakanni Subramanian, CEO Spell International and Ms. Arulmozhi Arasi, Editor-in-Chief, shared some interesting facts about perplexing rules and patterns of pronunciation in English Language. They informed the audience that English is not a phonetic language hence it doesn't have a governing body. Around 60% of English words have silent letters. Majority are actually Diacritic letters.



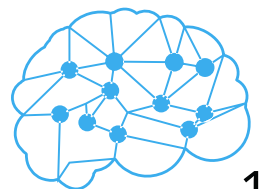
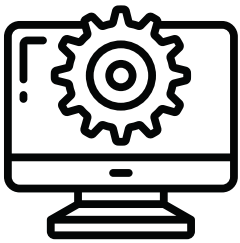

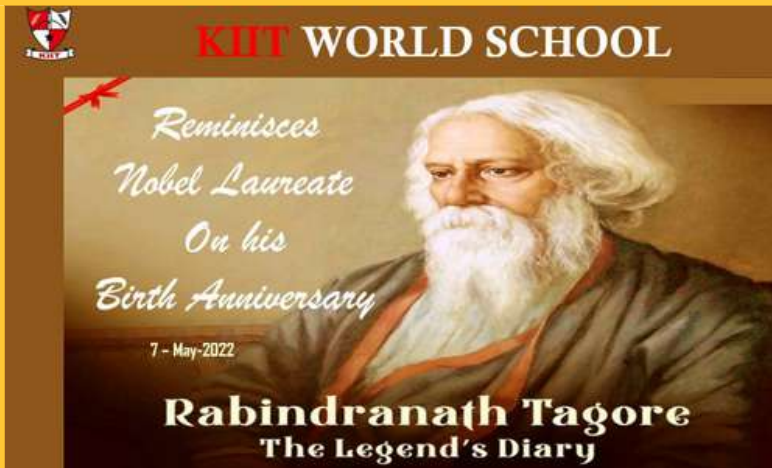
SAVE SOIL CAMPAIGN

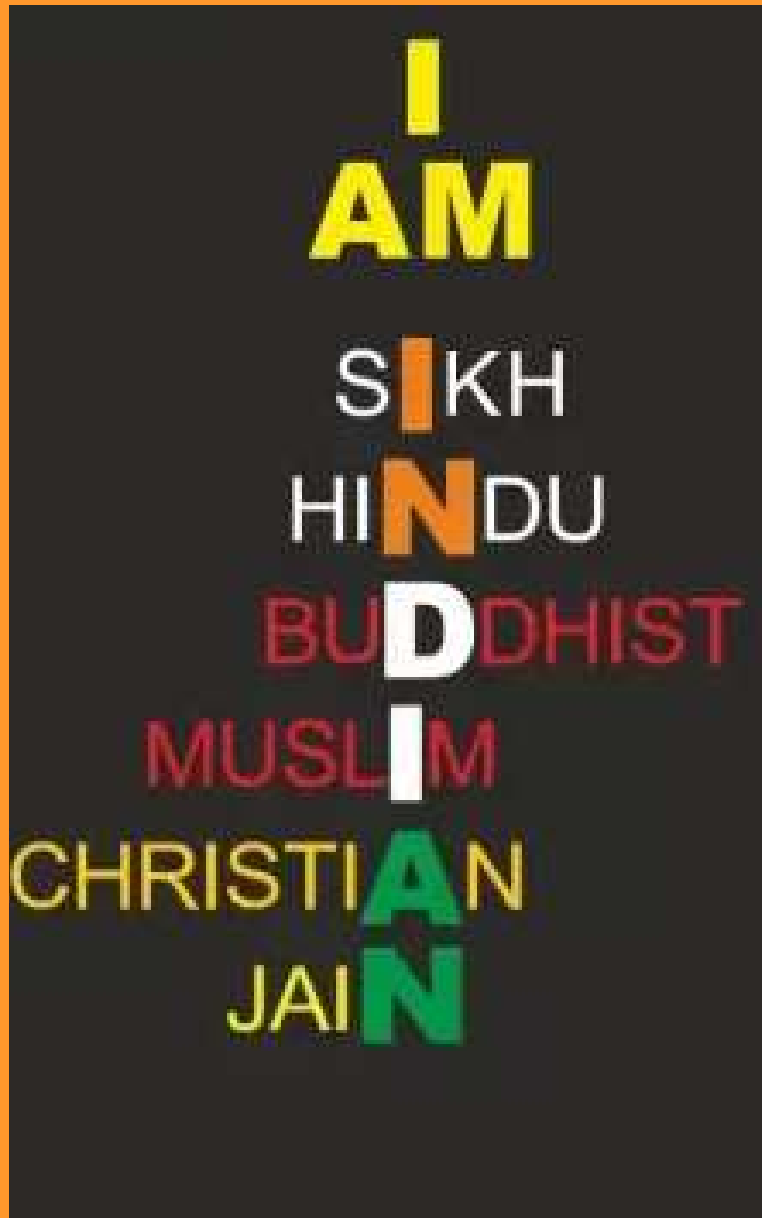
