



The theme of the conference, which was organised on the occasion of World Environment Day, was 'Let's nurture nature for a better future

The teachers and students from KIIT World School, Pitampura, attended a global conference held on the occasion of World Environment Day. The theme of the conference was 'Let's nurture nature for a better future'.

The guest speaker for the day was Souparno Banerjee from the Centre for Science and Environment. He apprised the audience of the harmful effects of plastic on the environment and what are the alternatives. He also talked about waste management, which is the need of the hour.

The guest speaker made the audience realise how small modifications in our lifestyle can bring about phenomenal change. Since we consume more, there is more generation of plastic waste. Sharing some shocking data on that critical issue, Banerjee said that 80 % of plastic waste is dumped, 79 % of all plastic produced ends up getting into oceans and water bodies and choking the life underwater, 12 % is burnt for generating energy and only 9 % is recycled.

All the major metro cities in India are the maximum producers of plas-tic waste, which is quite alarming. This is impacting the quality of life of people in those cities.

acknowledge that there is a need to take measures on a war footing and take responsibility for conserving the environment at individual, community and national levels. He encouraged the use of alternatives to plastics like bioplastics, biodegradable plastics, compostable plastics & conentional materials to name a few.

The session was followed by a quiz wherein the students answered the questions based on their understanding of the theme. The students shared ways to replace plastics in their daily lives like discarding the use of plastic straws, bottles and disposable cutlery, using cotton and jute bags for shopping, etc.

During the workshop, it was highlighted that the students from all the streams can further their chances in this upcoming industry and make a mark for themselves nationally and internationally.




